Other interesting tid bits ...

- We use 160 tons of sand during 2019 spring aeration of greens. Illahee is using 900-1,000 tons during the same time. The biggest difference is the aeration and sanding of fairways at Illahee.
- We have sold \$11,635 in firewood since 2014.
- We have a total of 548 valve boxes on the course. What is inside those valve boxes? Lateral valves, wire connections, mainline valves, drain clean outs, electric valves, back flow valves, pressure relief valves, capped lines, wye strainers, Otterbine wire connections, drain valves, city sewer cleanouts, lake fill valves, and air diffuser control valves. Every one of those valve boxes has been mapped, tagged, and measured for location. They all have a large stainless-steel washer on the lid that identifies that specific valve box with a letter or number for mapping purposes. Each spring we have to cut out around all 548 of those valve boxes so they don't get lost and are easy to locate when needed.
- When we walk mow greens, we walk a total of 15.6 miles (all 23 greens). When we walk
 mow the 18th green side-to-side it takes about 78 passes, and then three clean-up
 passes around the edge. It takes about approximately 30 minutes to walk mow 18 green
 if you are fast.
- All 2,182 sprinkler heads have been mapped and measured for location, and must be found and cleaned out around each spring.
